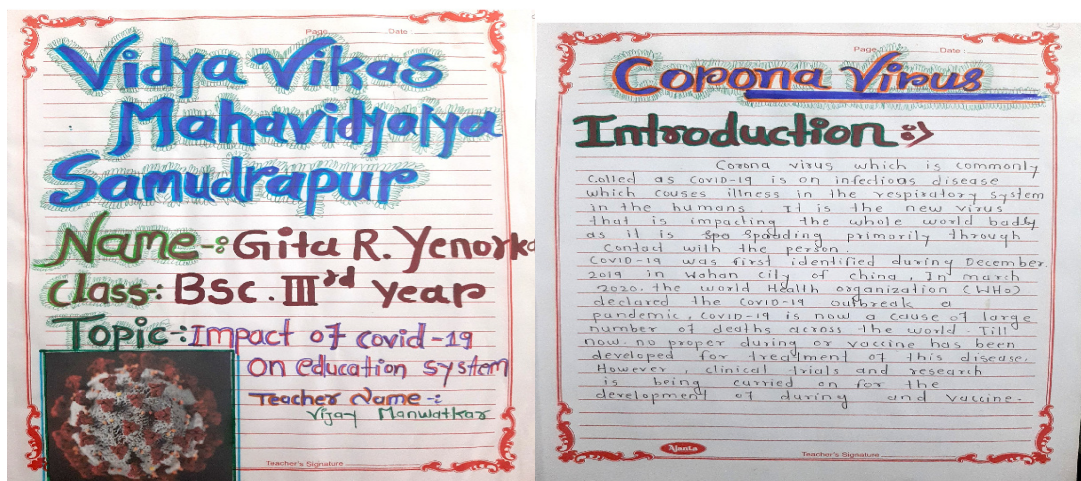

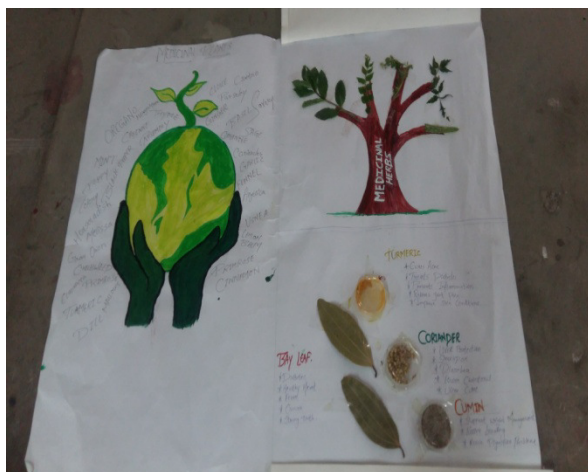
Brief Description:

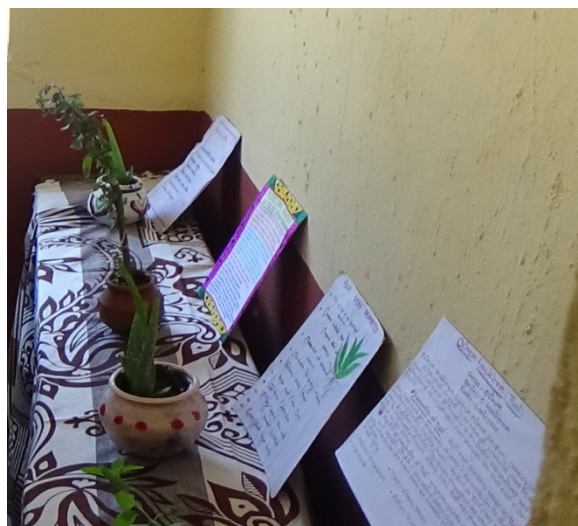

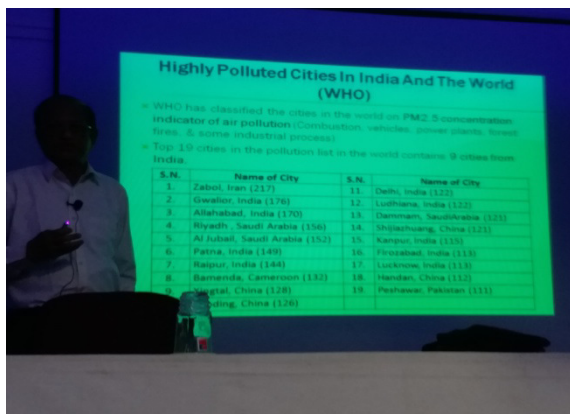
