- ❖ **Introduction of the event**
 - The NCC Units of the college organized **World Environment Day** on **5 June 2026** with the objective of creating awareness about environmental protection, biodiversity conservation, and sustainable living among students.
 - The programme commenced with the welcome of dignitaries. The event was presided over by **Principal Dr. K. G. Rewatkar**, while **Vice Principal Prof. M. N. Dhakre** graced the occasion as the Chief Guest. The programme was conducted in the presence of **NSS Programme Officer Dr. P. S. Tale** and **NCC Care Taker Officer Dr. R. G. Gajbhiye**.

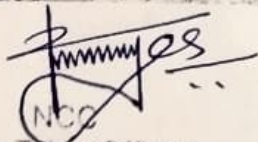

- The World Environment Day celebration successfully created awareness among students regarding environmental conservation and inspired them to contribute towards building a greener and healthier environment.



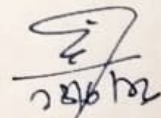
