Introduction of the event:

The programme began with a welcome and introductory remarks by Vice-Principal Prof. Meghashyam Dhakre, who explained the objectives behind organizing the programme. Hon'ble Judge Shri Prakash Patil In his presidential address, emphasized that every student must have proper legal knowledge. He elaborated on various provisions of the POCSO Act and explained their implications in detail. He further stated that misguidance often makes youth directionless, leading them to adopt wrong practices, and hence legal awareness is essential for shaping responsible citizens. Adv. Ulhas Ganvir, in his guiding speech, explained the significance of various Articles of the Constitution and appealed to the students to follow them for leading a prosperous life. Adv. Manoj Thute delivered an insightful lecture on Cyber Law, stressing the importance of legal knowledge in the digital age. Principal Dr. Kishorchandra Rewatkar urged students to use mobile phones judiciously and study Cyber Law for their own safety and awareness.
